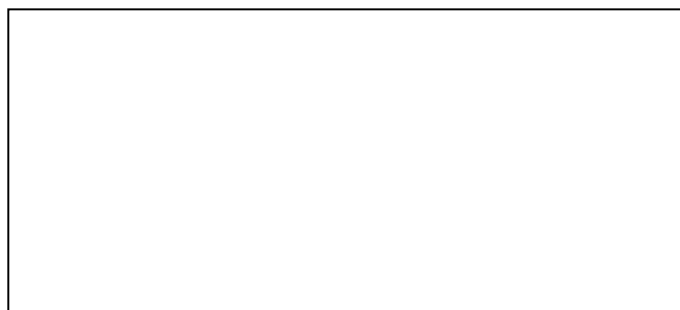

The Master's Message

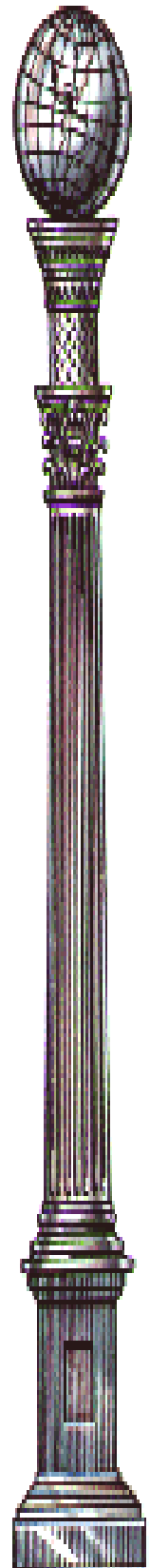
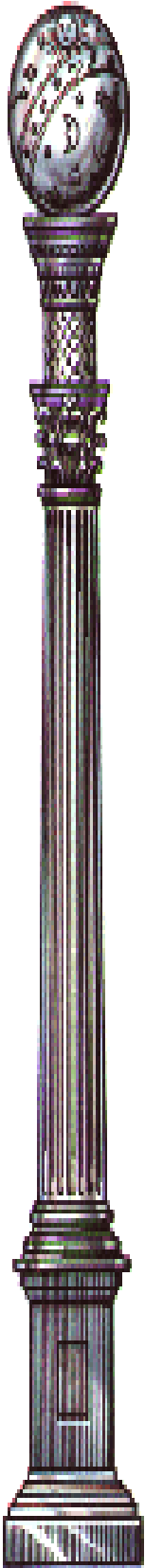
Many years ago when my grandfather died, dozens of men from his lodge all wearing black tuxedos and white gloves filed past his casket. Many men came to pay their last respects to a fallen brother, some of whom never even knew him. You could tell there was a very special bond between these “brothers” of Masonry. It was a moving service that gave great comfort to my grandmother and family. The scene spoke volumes about the fraternity that we all belong to.

Lately our lodge has had to deal with death more than we would like due to the untimely loss of our brothers: Charles Fleming, Elmer St. Lawrence, and Cliff Hendricks. Our Lodge has given Masonic Services for those families that requested it. This service is one of the most important duties we offer to all Masonic brothers whether they belong to our lodge or another. I believe our lodge has given a good effort in this area, but there's always room for improvement. While many grieve by attending the service or calling a fellow brother to pass on the sad news, many of us find it easier to keep to ourselves in sadness.

If you've never been to a Masonic service, our Lodge will be conducting a “Lodge of Remembrance” at our next stated meeting. This is a memorial service for all the brothers of Nathan Hale Lodge that have moved on to reside with the GAOTU. If you've never seen an official Masonic Service, it's very similar, and pays tribute to those no longer with us. As we read the names of those who have passed before, a bell will be rung in memory of each man. You may know some of the men better than others, but the ceremony of hearing each man's name, and the accompanying bell is very moving. I found it to be a meaningful experience in the past and hope you will too. If the thought of attending a funeral makes you uncomfortable, this is the perfect opportunity to pay respects to all of our past brothers.

I also want to urge all of you to let your families know that you desire a Masonic Service should it be your wish. Often times the surviving family doesn't know the wishes of a departed Mason. Please make some type of record and put it with those important documents that need to be passed on to your loved ones or inform our lodge secretary, and a record will be saved. The next time you see the “Square and Compasses” printed in the newspaper next to a deceased brother, please make every effort to attend *“if within the length of your cabletow.”* It is our duty as Masons.
